

SEISMOGRAPH

Meaning: A seismograph is an instrument that detects and records the intensity and duration of seismic waves produced by earthquakes or volcanic activity.

1. The seismograph recorded the tremors of the earthquake with remarkable accuracy.
2. Scientists rely on seismographs to monitor volcanic activity and predict eruptions.
3. After the tremor, the seismograph showed a series of small aftershocks.
4. In the geology lab, students learned how to interpret the data from a seismograph.
5. The installation of advanced seismographs has improved our understanding of tectonic plate movements.

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
