

SEIZURE

Meaning: Seizure refers to the act of taking possession of someone's property or assets, often by legal authority, or a sudden attack of a medical condition, such as convulsions or loss of consciousness.

1. The sudden seizure of the suspect's assets raised questions about the legality of the operation.
2. During the meeting, she explained the medical implications of a seizure and how to respond appropriately.
3. After experiencing a seizure, he was advised to avoid driving for at least six months.
4. The police conducted a seizure of illegal drugs found in the warehouse.
5. Witnesses reported a chaotic scene after someone in the crowd experienced a seizure.
