

# SELF-CONSIDERING

*Meaning: Self-considering: primarily concerned with one's own interests or opinions, often at the expense of acknowledging the needs of others.*

1. His self-considering nature often led him to overlook the needs of others.
2. In discussions, she tended to be self-considering, focusing more on her own opinions than on collaborative dialogue.
3. The self-considering attitude of some leaders can hinder team cohesion and trust.
4. They accused him of being self-considering, as he rarely acknowledged the contributions of his colleagues.
5. Her self-considering approach to problem-solving ultimately limited the creativity of the team's solutions.
