

SELF-EVIDENCE

Meaning: Self-evidence refers to a truth or principle that is clear and obvious without needing further proof or explanation.

1. The principle of gravity is a self-evidence that many take for granted.
2. In philosophical debates, self-evidence is often a point of contention among scholars.
