

SELF-EXISTENT

Meaning: Self-existent: existing independently and not contingent upon anything else for existence, often used to describe a being, such as God, that is necessary and uncaused.

1. The philosopher argued that the concept of a self-existent being is essential to understanding the universe.
2. In many religious traditions, God is often described as self-existent, needing no external cause for existence.
3. The idea of a self-existent reality challenges the notion that everything must have a creator.
4. Some scientists propose that the laws of nature may be self-existent, existing independently of any physical manifestation.
5. In metaphysics, self-existence is often debated in relation to the nature of identity and existence itself.
