Meaning: Self-justifier: a person who rationalizes their actions or decisions to avoid accepting responsibility or accountability.

1. His tendency to blame others revealed him as a self-justifier rather than someone willing to take responsibility.
2. In discussions, she often played the role of a self-justifier, always finding a way to excuse her actions.
3. The self-justifier in him made it difficult for him to acknowledge his mistakes and learn from them.
4. Rather than admitting fault, he became a self-justifier, crafting elaborate explanations to defend his choices.
5. Her self-justifier mentality often hindered her relationships, as others found it challenging to confront her about issues.
