

SEMICASTRATE

Meaning: Semicastrate: to surgically remove only part of the reproductive organs of an animal to reduce aggressive behavior or improve certain traits without completely sterilizing the animal.

1. The veterinarian explained that to semicastrate the dog would help reduce aggressive behavior.
2. Farmers sometimes opt to semicastrate livestock to improve meat quality while maintaining certain breeding characteristics.
3. During the study, researchers noted that animals that were semicastrated showed different social dynamics within their groups.
