

SEMISOLID

Meaning: Semisolid: having a consistency that is between solid and liquid, often thick and not easily pourable.

1. The paste was too semisolid to be easily spread on the toast.
2. In the lab, we observed a semisolid gel forming in the reaction mixture.
3. The semisolid consistency of the batter indicated that it was ready for baking.
4. Some ointments have a semisolid texture that allows for easy application on the skin.
5. During the experiment, the substance transitioned from a liquid to a semisolid state.
