Meaning: Semitonic refers to a musical scale or interval that is based on a half step (semitone), often used to create tension or emotional depth in melodies.

1. The composer utilized a semitonic scale to create a sense of tension in the melody.

3. The unique semitonic structure of the song gave it an innovative sound that intrigued listeners.
