Meaning: Sepal: a modified leaf that typically encloses and protects the developing flower bud and is often green or leaf-like in appearance.

1. The sepal of the flower is often mistaken for its petals due to their similar appearance.
2. Botanists study the structure of the sepal to understand the reproductive systems of various plants.
3. In some species, the sepals provide protection for the developing bud before it blooms.
4. The vibrant color of the sepal can attract pollinators even before the flower opens.
5. During classification, the size and shape of the sepal can help distinguish between different plant species.
