Meaning: Se pose (verb): to assume or suppose something to be true for the sake of argument or consideration.

1. If we sepose that the weather will improve, we can plan our picnic for the weekend.
2. Many scientists sepose that dark matter makes up a significant portion of the universe.
3. In the discussion, they chose to sepose alternative outcomes for the project's success.
4. The teacher asked the students to sepose what might happen if the experiment were repeated.
5. During the debate, she began to sepose the consequences of ignoring climate change.
