

SEQUESTRABLE

Meaning: Sequestable refers to assets or funds that can be legally seized or set apart to satisfy a judgment or comply with regulations.

1. Assets that are deemed sequestable may be seized in order to satisfy a legal judgment.
2. The court ruled that the funds in the offshore account were sequestable under the new financial regulations.
3. In cases of bankruptcy, certain properties can be classified as sequestable to ensure fair distribution to creditors.
