

SEQUESTRATOR

Meaning: A sequestrator is an individual or entity appointed to take control of and manage assets or a group, often in legal contexts, to ensure their protection or integrity during proceedings.

2. In some jurisdictions, a sequestered jury is monitored by a sequestrator to prevent outside influence.
3. After the company declared bankruptcy, a sequester was appointed as the official sequestrator to manage the liquidation process.

5. As a sequester, the sequestrotor had to ensure that all parties adhered to the confidentiality agreements during the trial.

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
