*Meaning: SEROUS: relating to or resembling serum, especially in being thin, watery, and often associated with inflammation or secretion from serous glands.*

1. The doctor explained that the serous fluid accumulation was a sign of inflammation.
2. In histology, serous glands are known for producing a watery secretion.
3. The serous membrane surrounding the lungs helps reduce friction during breathing.
4. She was relieved to learn that the cyst was filled with serous rather than purulent fluid.
