

SERRATIOSTRAL

Meaning: SERRATIOSTRAL: having a saw-like or serrated beak shape, particularly adapted for extracting insects from narrow spaces.

1. The serratiostral beak of the bird allows it to expertly extract insects from crevices in the bark.
2. Scientists classified the new species based on its unique serratiostral characteristics.
3. In her research, she noted that the serratiostral features of the finch provided an advantage in foraging.
4. The serratiostral adaptation has evolved in several bird species to enhance their feeding efficiency.
