

# SESTET

*Meaning: A sestet is a six-line stanza or the final six lines of a Petrarchan sonnet that typically presents a resolution or counterargument.*

1. The sestet in Petrarchan sonnets often presents a resolution or counterargument to the preceding octave.
2. In her analysis of the poem, she highlighted how the sestet effectively changes the tone and direction of the piece.
3. The poet chose to use a sestet to create a sense of closure and finality in his work.
4. Many classic sonnets feature a sestet that provides a poignant reflection on the themes introduced earlier.
5. Understanding the structure of a sestet can greatly enhance one's appreciation of traditional poetry forms.
