Meaning: Shakedown: a thorough search or investigation, often conducted by law enforcement, typically aimed at uncovering illegal activities or contraband.

1. The police conducted a shakedown of the local gang, hoping to uncover hidden weapons.
2. After the shakedown at the nightclub, several patrons were arrested for drug possession.
3. The company faced a shakedown from an aggressive competitor trying to push them out of business.
4. During the investigation, the detectives discovered evidence of a shakedown scheme involving city officials.
5. His aggressive tactics during negotiations felt more like a shakedown than a business deal.
