1. The old table was so shaky that it rattled every time someone placed a drink on it.
2. She felt a shaky uncertainty as she approached the microphone to give her speech.
3. After the earthquake, the buildings looked shaky and in need of immediate repairs.
4. His hands were shaky from the excitement of winning the award.
5. The shaky bridge swayed perilously as the cars drove over it.
