

SHEATHE

Meaning: To sheathe means to place a blade or tool into a protective covering or case.

1. He decided to sheathe his sword after realizing the fight was unnecessary.
2. The artist chose to sheathe her brushes in a protective case to prevent damage.
3. In moments of frustration, he would often sheathe his emotions behind a stoic façade.
4. The knight vowed to sheathe his weapon only when peace had been restored to the kingdom.
5. After the storm, she was careful to sheathe the garden tools to avoid rusting.
