Meaning: To shy (or shie) away means to avoid or recoil from something due to fear, discomfort, or timidity.

1. She couldn't help but shie away from the loud crowd at the concert.
2. After the embarrassing incident, he tended to shie from social gatherings.
3. The shy child would often shie when asked to speak in front of the class.
4. Whenever the topic turned serious, he would shie from the discussion.
5. Feeling overwhelmed, she began to shie from the responsibilities laid upon her.
