Meaning: A shim is a thin, often tapered piece of material used to fill gaps or provide support in order to level or align objects.

1. She used a shim to level the uneven table.
2. The carpenter added a shim between the door frame and the wall to ensure a snug fit.
3. After installing the new cabinet, he realized he needed a shim to adjust its height.
4. They placed a shim under the washing machine to reduce the vibrations during spin cycles.
5. To fix the alignment issue, he inserted a thin shim behind the brackets.
