

SHIVE

Meaning: A 'shive' is a tool or implement used for shaping or decorating, particularly in baking, or refers to the act of shedding or falling off, as in leaves from trees.

1. The baker used a shive to create a delicate pattern on the top of the pie crust.
2. As the wind picked up, leaves began to shive off the trees, creating a beautiful autumn scene.
3. In the dim light of the old library, the shive of shadow danced across the walls.
