

SHOWBREAD

Meaning: Showbread is a ceremonial bread, traditionally placed in the holy sanctuary of ancient Israel, representing God's provision and sustenance.

1. The ancient Israelites placed showbread on the table of the holy sanctuary.
2. During the festival, the priest replaced the old showbread with fresh loaves as a symbol of God's provision.
