Meaning: Sideflash: a sudden burst or reflection of light, often seen in photography or during a storm, that illuminates an area momentarily.

1. The photographer captured a stunning sideflash of light reflecting off the water.
2. During the storm, a sideflash of lightning illuminated the entire landscape.
3. The car's headlights created a sideflash that momentarily blinded the oncoming driver.
4. In the play, the special effects team used a sideflash to enhance the dramatic scene.
