

SIDELING

Meaning: Sidelong or sideways in movement or glance, often used to avoid attention or detection.

1. The cat approached the bird, moving sideling to avoid detection.
2. She glanced sideling at her friends, hoping for support during the presentation.
3. The child crept sideling behind the couch, trying to surprise his father.
4. As the team strategized, he listened sideling, picking up on their ideas.
