Meaning: A sieve is a utensil with a mesh or perforated surface used to separate coarse from fine substances or to strain liquids from solids.

1. She used a fine mesh sieve to separate the flour from the lumps.
2. After the storm, we had to sift through the debris like a sieve to find anything salvageable.
3. The chef recommended using a sieve to strain the sauce for a smoother texture.
4. He felt his patience was wearing thin as he sifted through the endless paperwork like a sieve.
