

SIGHT-HOLE

Meaning: SIGHT-HOLE: a small opening or window in a container or machinery that allows for visual inspection of internal conditions or levels.

1. The engineer inspected the sight-hole to ensure it was free of obstructions.
2. During the routine check, the technician peered through the sight-hole to gauge the fluid levels.
3. The sight-hole on the tank allowed us to monitor the contents without opening it.
4. She pointed out the sight-hole to her colleague, highlighting its importance in the maintenance process.
