

SIGNATORY

Meaning: A signatory is a person or entity that has formally signed a document, thereby agreeing to its terms and conditions.

1. The signatory agreed to the terms outlined in the contract.
2. Each signatory is responsible for upholding the commitments made in the agreement.
3. As a signatory to the treaty, the country pledged to protect the environment.
4. The organization is recognized as a key signatory in the international peace negotiations.
