

SILICLE

Meaning: Silicle: a short, narrow fruit, typically found in certain plants, that contains seeds and splits open when mature.

1. The silicle of the plant was filled with tiny seeds ready for dispersal.
2. Botanists often study the structure of a silicle to understand plant evolution.
3. In some species, the silicle can be mistaken for a silique due to their similar shapes.
4. The silicle's distinctive shape helps in identifying various species within the mustard family.
5. After the rain, the silicle burst open, scattering seeds across the damp soil.
