

SIMMER

Meaning: SIMMER: To cook food gently in liquid at a temperature just below boiling, allowing flavors to develop.

1. The chef instructed us to let the sauce simmer for at least an hour to develop its flavors.
2. As the water began to boil, I lowered the heat so it would just simmer gently.
