Meaning: SIPHONATE (verb): To transfer a liquid from one container to another using a tube, often by creating a vacuum or using gravity.

1. To siphonate the liquid from the tank, he used a clear plastic tube.
2. The researchers had to siphonate the samples carefully to avoid contamination.
3. She learned how to siphonate the wine from the barrel without disturbing the sediment.
4. To siphonate the excess water from the flooded area, they devised a simple pump system.
5. He watched as the scientist prepared to siphonate the solution from the beaker.
