Meaning: Slighting refers to the act of treating someone or something with disrespect or neglect, often by making dismissive or disparaging remarks.

3. The slighting tone she used while discussing the project left many feeling undervalued.
4. It was uncharacteristic of him to engage in slighting humor, especially in front of clients.
5. Slighting someone intentionally can damage relationships and create lasting resentment.
