Meaning: SNIPE: (noun) a wading bird with a long bill, commonly found in marshy areas; (verb) to make critical or mocking remarks, often in a sneaky or indirect manner.

1. The hunter took aim at the snipe as it fluttered through the tall grass.
2. Critics often snipe at the director's choices, but he remains confident in his vision.
3. During the game, the player managed to snipe the opposing team's goal from a great distance.
4. Some people tend to snipe at others online, hiding behind the anonymity of social media.
5. The birdwatcher was thrilled to finally spot a rare snipe in its natural habitat.
