Meaning: SNOODED: Adorned or enveloped in a snood, often referring to a cozy or protective covering, or in a relaxed position, as if wrapped or nestled.

3. The artist captured the moment of the rabbit snooded in its cozy burrow.
4. As the evening approached, he snooded his hair to keep it out of his face.
