

SOCAGE

Meaning: Socage is a feudal land tenure system in which tenants are required to provide specific services or payments to a landlord in exchange for the use of land.

1. The medieval system of socage required tenants to provide certain services in exchange for land.
2. Under the terms of socage, the farmer was obliged to work the land for a specified number of days each year.
3. Many historical records detail the various forms of socage that existed in different regions.
4. Socage was often seen as a more favorable arrangement compared to feudal obligations.
5. The transition from socage to more modern forms of land tenure marked a significant shift in agricultural practices.
