

SOLATIUM

Meaning: Solatium is a monetary compensation awarded for emotional distress or grief resulting from an injury or wrongful death.

1. The court awarded her a solatium for the emotional distress caused by the accident.
2. In cases of wrongful death, families often seek a solatium to compensate for their loss.
3. He received a solatium from the government after his property was unjustly seized.
4. The insurance policy included a solatium clause for victims of traumatic events.
