

SOLSTICE

Meaning: Solstice refers to the two points in the year when the sun reaches its highest or lowest point in the sky at noon, resulting in the longest or shortest day of the year.

1. The summer solstice marks the longest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere.
2. Many ancient cultures celebrated the winter solstice with festivals and rituals.
3. As the solstice approached, the days grew noticeably longer and warmer.
4. Astronomers often use the solstice to explain Earth's tilt and its effect on seasons.
5. During the solstice, some people gather to witness the sunrise at ancient monuments like Stonehenge.

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
