Meaning: SORB (verb): to absorb or take up a substance, such as liquid or nutrients, through physical or chemical means.

1. The sponge was able to sorb the excess water from the floor after the spill.
2. Certain plants have evolved to sorb nutrients from the soil more efficiently than others.
3. Researchers are investigating materials that can sorb harmful chemicals from the environment.
4. The new filter is designed to sorb pollutants, making the air cleaner to breathe.
5. In her experiment, she demonstrated how activated charcoal can sorb toxins from liquids.
