

SOVEREIGNIZE

Meaning: SOVEREIGNIZE (verb): To assert or establish control and authority over resources or industries, often with the aim of enhancing economic independence and governance.

1. The country sought to sovereignize its resources to regain control over its economy.
2. Activists argued that the government must sovereignize local industries to promote sustainable development.
3. In the face of foreign intervention, the nation decided to sovereignize its political decisions more aggressively.
