

SPALE

Meaning: Spale: a thin, flat piece or shaving of wood, often removed during the process of shaping or cutting timber.

1. The craftsman carefully removed a spale from the edge of the wooden plank.

3. He used the spale to create intricate designs on the surface of the handmade furniture.
