

SPATHIFORM

Meaning: Spathiform: having a shape resembling a spathe, typically broad and leaf-like, often used to describe certain flowers or plant structures.

1. The spathiform shape of the flower made it a striking feature in the garden.
2. Artists often seek to replicate the spathiform structure of certain plants in their sculptures.
3. The botanist noted the spathiform leaves as a key characteristic of the species.
4. During the presentation, she highlighted the spathiform arrangement of the petals.
5. In ancient texts, the spathiform designs were frequently associated with purity and beauty.
