Meaning: Speculation is the formation of a theory or conjecture without firm evidence, often related to financial investments or hypothetical ideas.

1. The investment was based on pure speculation rather than solid evidence.
2. Her theories about the origins of the artifact were dismissed as mere speculation.
3. In the absence of concrete information, speculation about the company's future ran rampant.
4. The media's speculation regarding the celebrity's personal life generated a lot of buzz.
5. While speculation can sometimes lead to interesting insights, it can also result in misinformation.
