

SPICCATO

Meaning: Spiccato is a bowing technique in string instruments where the bow is bounced lightly on the strings to produce a detached, lively sound.

1. The violinist executed the spiccato technique with such precision that each note seemed to dance in the air.
2. In her performance, the spiccato passages added a lively and playful character to the otherwise somber piece.
3. Spiccato is often used in orchestral music to create a light, bouncing effect that captivates the audience.
4. Learning to master spiccato can take time, but it ultimately enhances a string player's expressive capabilities.
5. The conductor emphasized the importance of clarity in the spiccato sections during the rehearsal.
