Meaning: A spore is a reproductive cell capable of developing into a new organism, often produced by fungi, plants, and some bacteria, and typically dispersed through the air or water.

1. The mushroom released its spores into the air, hoping to find a suitable place to grow.
2. Botanists study the spore patterns of different plants to understand their reproductive strategies.
3. During the rainy season, the forest floor becomes covered with a fine layer of fungal spores.
4. Some ferns reproduce by dispersing spores, which can survive in harsh environments for many years.
5. In a laboratory, scientists carefully collect and examine the spores of various algae species.

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
