

SPOROZOITE

Meaning: Sporozoite: a motile, infectious stage of certain parasitic protozoa, particularly in the life cycle of malaria-causing Plasmodium, that is transmitted to a host and is crucial for initiating infection.

1. The sporozoite stage of the parasite is essential for initiating the infection in the host organism.
2. In malaria, sporozoites are injected into the bloodstream by the Anopheles mosquito during a bite.
3. Researchers are studying how sporozoites evade the immune system in order to develop more effective vaccines.
4. Sporozoites have a unique ability to rapidly invade liver cells, where they undergo further development.
5. Understanding the biology of sporozoites could lead to breakthroughs in treating parasitic infections.

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
