*Meaning: SQUAMOID: resembling or having characteristics similar to scales, particularly in relation to skin lesions or histological features.*

1. The term 'squamous' is often used in dermatology to describe certain skin lesions resembling scales.
2. During the histological examination, the pathologist noted the squamous features of the tumor.
3. The researcher focused on the squamous characteristics to better understand the disease's progression.
4. In morphology, squamous structures can indicate a particular developmental stage in certain organisms.
5. The squamous appearance of the cells suggested a possible link to squamous cell carcinoma.
