

SQUINCH

Meaning: SQUINCH: A structural element that supports a dome by transitioning from a square or polygonal base, or the act of narrowing the eyes to reduce light or improve focus.

1. The architect decided to use a squinch to transition elegantly between the square base and the dome above.
2. As she squinched her eyes against the bright sunlight, she tried to make out the figures in the distance.
3. The ancient mosque featured stunning squinches that supported its magnificent vaulted ceilings.
4. He squinched his brow in confusion, trying to understand the complex instructions given by his teacher.
5. The artist captured the moment perfectly, showing a child squinching in delight as they tasted ice cream for the first time.
