

# STALKING-HORSE

*Meaning: A stalking-horse is a person or entity used to mask the true intentions of another, often employed to gauge public opinion or to establish a baseline bid in financial transactions.*

1. The politician used a stalking-horse to test public opinion on the controversial policy without revealing his true intentions.
2. In the corporate world, a stalking-horse bid can help determine the market value of a struggling company during a bankruptcy sale.
3. She acted as a stalking-horse for the organization, allowing them to gauge the reactions of the community while remaining anonymous.
4. The company hired a stalking-horse candidate to explore the possibility of gaining employee support for its new leadership strategy.
5. As a stalking-horse, he proposed an alternative plan that would later be dismissed, providing cover for the more radical changes the board wanted to implement.

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
