*Meaning: Stander: a person who remains in an upright position, often used to describe someone who stands in a particular context, such as in a debate or at an event.*

1. The teacher praised the student for being a reliable stander in the school's debate team.
2. As a stander at the concert, she had a perfect view of the stage.
3. He was known as a staunch stander for animal rights within his community.
4. The stander at the bus stop adjusted his umbrella as the rain began to pour.
5. In the crowded room, the standers often had to shift to make space for those arriving late.
