Meaning: Steepen (verb): to increase in slope or intensity, either in a physical incline or in the concentration of a substance.

2. To improve the flavor, the chef decided to steepen the sauce by adding more herbs.
3. As the car climbed the winding road, the incline began to steepen noticeably.
4. The teacher aimed to steepen her students' interest in science through hands-on experiments.
5. The river's current seemed to steepen after the recent rain, making it more challenging to navigate.
